Hantaan virus (strain 76-118) (Korean hemorrhagic fever virus) pre-Gc protein, His Tag (PRN-V52H4) is expressed from human 293 cells (HEK293). It contains AA Ser 649 - Asn 1105 (Accession # [P08668](#)).

Molecular Characterization

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This protein carries a polyhistidine tag at the C-terminus.

The protein has a calculated MW of 52.5 kDa. The protein migrates as 54-60 kDa when calibrated against [Star Ribbon Pre-stained Protein Marker](#) under non-reducing (NR) condition (SDS-PAGE) due to glycosylation.

Endotoxin

Less than 1.0 EU per µg by the LAL method.

Purity

>95% as determined by SDS-PAGE.

>90% as determined by SEC-MALS.

Formulation

Lyophilized from 0.22 µm filtered solution in PBS, 0.5 M Argine, pH 7.3 with trehalose as protectant.

Storage

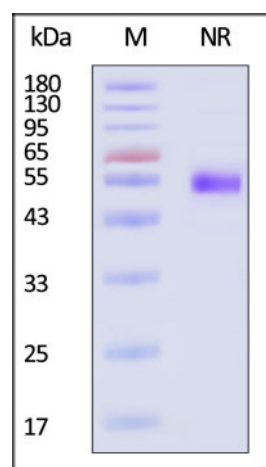
For long term storage, the product should be stored at lyophilized state at -20°C or lower.

Please avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

This product is stable after storage at:

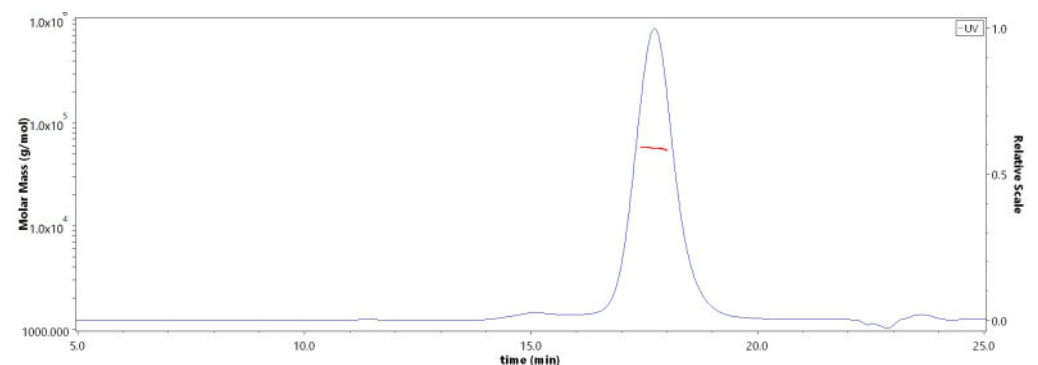
- -20°C to -70°C for 12 months in lyophilized state;
- -70°C for 3 months under sterile conditions after reconstitution.
