**** SECTION 2 - HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION ****

EMERGENCY OVERVIEW

Eye: Potassium chloride can cause eye irritation, including redness, tearing, and possible abrasions. Skin: Sodium Phosphate is a corrosive material and can cause burns.
